***The Whatnot* - Bachmann, Stefan (T, J)**

Companion to *The Peculiar* (J)

Bartholomew Keble, unable to save his sister, Hele when she was pushed into the faery Old Country, promised he would find her but sinister forces are at work and he must rely on Pikey, who would do almost anything to escape his past, to help find her.

***The Darkest Part of the Forest* - Black, Holly (T)**

In the town of Fairfold, where humans and fae exist side by side, a boy with horns on his head and ears as pointed as knives awakes after generations of sleep in a glass coffin in the woods, causing Hazel to be swept up in new love, shield her loyalies, feel the fresh sting of betrayal, and to make a secret sacrifice to the faerie king.

***Faerie Wars* - Brennan, Herbie (E)**

Sequels: *The Purple Emperor*, *Ruler of the Realm*, & two more

Troubled by family problems, Henry finds his life taking a whole new dimension when he and his friend, old Mr. Fogarty, become involved with Prince Pyrgus Malvae who has been sent from the faerie world in order to escape the treacherous Faeries of the Night.

***Stardust* - Gaiman, Neil (A, M)**

The story of young Tristran Thorn and his adventures in the land of Faerie. He has fallen in love with beautiful Victoria Forester and in order to win her hand, he must retrieve a fallen star and deliver it to her.

***Need* - Jones, Carrie (T)**

Sequels: *Capivate*, *Enlace*, & *Endure*

Depressed after the death of her stepfather, high school junior Zara goes to live with her grand-mother in a small Maine town, where new friends tell Zara the strange man she keeps seeing may be a pixie king, and that only "were" creatures can stop him from taking souls.

***The Iron King* - Kagawa, Julie (T)**

Sequels: *The Iron Daughter*, *The Iron Queen*, & *The Iron Knight*

Something has always felt slightly off in Meghan's life, ever since her father disappeared before her eyes when she was six. She has never quite fit in at school... or at home. When a dark stranger begins watching her from afar, and her prankster best friend becomes strangely protective of her, Meghan senses that everything she knows is about to change.

***Winterspell* - Legrand, Claire (T)**

To find her abducted father and keep her sister safe from the lecherous politicians of 1899 New York City, seventeen-year-old Clara must journey to the wintry kingdom of Cane, where Anise, queen of the faeries, has ousted the royal family in favor of her own totalitarian, anti-human regime.

***Ash* - Lo, Malinda (T)**

In this variation on the Cinderella story, Ash grows up believing in the fairy realm that the king and his philosophers have sought to suppress, until one day she must choose between a handsome fairy cursed to love her and the King's Huntress whom she loves.

***Wondrous Strange* - Livingston, Lesley (T)**

Sequels: *Darklight & Tempestuous*

Also try: *Starling, Descendant, & Transcendent*

When seventeen-year-old actress Kelley Winslow meets Sonny Flannery, she discovers he is a changeling and guardian of the gate between the faerie Otherworld and the mortal realm. She also learns that her mother had otherworldly powers that she has passed on to Kelley.

***Faery Tales & Nightmares* - Marr, Melissa (T)**

Short stories featuring tales of characters from the Wicked Lovely novels that mix with accounts of new characters.

***Wicked Lovely* - Marr, Melissa (T)**

Sequels: *Fragile Eternity, Radiant Shadows, & Darkest Mercy*

Companions: *Ink Exchange & Desert Tales*

Seventeen-year-old Aislinn, who has the ability to see faeries, is drawn against her will into a centuries-old battle between the Summer King and the Winter Queen, and the survival of her life, her love, and summer all hang in the balance.

***The Hunter's Moon* - Melling, O. R. (J)**

Sequels: *The Summer King, The Light-Bearer's Daughter, & The Book of Dreams*

Two teenage cousins, one Irish, the other from the United States, set out to find a magic doorway to the Faraway Country, where humans must bow to the little people.

***The Summer King* - Melling, O.R. (T)**

Sequel to *The Hunter's Moon*

Seventeen-year-old Laurel returns to her grandparents' home in Ireland, where she encounters "the roly-poly man," a cluricaun who sets Laurel on a quest to free her twin sister, thought to be dead, to live with her lover in the legendary world of Faerie.

***The Faery Reel: Tales from the Twilight Realm* - Various Authors (T - FAERY)**

A collection of stories and poems about faeries in all parts of the world by a variety of authors.

***Wings* - Pike, Aprilynne (T)**

Sequels: *Spells, Illusions, & Desined*

When a plant blooms out of fifteen-year-old Laurel's back, it leads her to discover the fact that she is a faerie and has a crucial role to play in keeping the world safe from encroaching enemy trolls.

***I Am Morgan le Fay: A Tale From Camelot* - Springer, Nancy (J)**

In a war-torn England where her half-brother Arthur will eventually become king, the young Morgan le Fay comes to realize that she has magic powers and links to the faerie world.

***Lament: The Faerie Queen's Deception* - Stiefvater, Maggie (E)**

Sequel: *Ballad: A Gathering of Faerie*

On the day of an important music competition, talented but painfully introverted and nervous Deirdre Monaghan is helped to perform by the compelling and enigmatic Luke Dillon and finds herself inexorably drawn into the mysteries and dangers of the faerie world.

***Ballad: A Gathering of Faerie* - Stiefvater, Maggie (T, E)**

Sequel to *Lament*

When music prodigy James Morgan and his best friend, Deirdre, join a private conservatory for musicians, his talent attracts Nuala, a faerie muse who fosters and feeds on creative energies, but soon he finds himself battling the Queen of the Fey for the very lives of Deirdre and Nuala.

***Extraordinary* - Werlin, Nancy (T)**

Phoebe, a member of the wealthy Rothschilds family, befriends Mallory, an awkward new girl in school, and the two become as close as sisters, but Phoebe does not know that Mallory is a faerie, sent to the human world to trap the ordinary human girl into fulfilling a promise made by her ancestor Mayer to the queen of the faeries.
