After she has served a year of hard labor in the salt mines of Endovier for her crimes, Crown Prince Dorian offers assassin Celaena Sardothien her freedom on the condition that she act as his champion in a competition to find a new royal assassin.

#### Cinder - Meyer, Marissa (T)

Sequels: Scarlet, Cress, Fairest, & Winter
As plague ravages the overcrowded Earth, Cinder, a gifted mechanic and cyborg, becomes involved with handsome
Prince Kai and must uncover secrets about her past in order to protect the world in this futuristic take on Cinderella.

#### A Girl Like Me - Simone, Ni-Ni (T)

She's got a voice like Keisha Cole, attitude to burn and is the body-rockin' girl everyone in her high school wants to be. But in real life, sixteen-year-old Elite has a crack-addicted mother and no father in sight. Now a radio contest has put her upclose-and-personal with mega-hot singer Hanseef and their chemistry is too sizzling for Elite to stop pretending. As the clock ticks down fast for this hood Cinderella, she has one shot to save her family and make her dreams come true.

#### Stitching Snow - Lewis, R.C. (T)

A futuristic retelling of Snow White in which Essie, a master at repairing robots and drones on the frozen mining planet Thanda, is pulled into a war by handsome and mysterious Dane after his shuttle crash-lands near her home.

#### A Court of Thorns and Roses - Maas, Sarah J. (T, E)

Dragged to a treacherous magical land she only knows about from stories, Feyre discovers that her captor is not an animal, but Tamlin, a High Lord of the faeries. As her feelings toward him transform from hostility to a fiery passion, the threats against the faerie lands grow. Feyre must fight to break an ancient curse, or she will lose Tamlin forever.

#### Rapunzel's Revenge - Hale, Shannon (TG - RAPUNZEL'S)

Rapunzel is raised in a grand villa surrounded by towering walls. Rapunzel dreams of a different mother than Gothel, the woman she calls Mother. She climbs over the wall and finds out the truth. Her real mother, Kate, is a slave in Gothel's gold mine. In this Old West retelling, Rapunzel uses her hair as a lasso and to take on outlaws — including Gothel.
