Atwater-Rhodes, Amelia: Demon In My View

Seventeen-year-old Jessica Allodola discovers that the vampire world of her fiction is real when she develops relationships with an alluring vampire named Aubrey and the teenage witch who is trying to save Jessica from his clutches. 1st in a series

Brewer, Heather: The Chronicles of Vladimir Tod: Eighth Grade Bites

For thirteen years, Vlad, aided by his aunt and best friend, has kept secret that he is half-vampire, but when his missing teacher is replaced by a sinister substitute, he learns that there is more to being a vampire, and to his parents' deaths, than he could have guessed. 1st in a series

Cast, P.C.: Marked

16 year-old Zoey enters the House of Night, a school where, after having undergone the Change, she will train to become an adult vampire--that is, if she makes it through the Change. 1st in a series

De La Cruz, Melissa: Blue Bloods

Select teenagers from some of New York City's wealthiest and most socially prominent families learn a startling secret about their bloodlines. 1st in a series

Gray, Claudia: Evernight

Sixteen-year-old Bianca, a new girl at the sinister Evernight boarding school, finds herself drawn to another outsider, Jared, but dark forces threaten to tear them apart and destroy Bianca's entire world. 1st in a series

Hautman, Pete: Sweetblood

After a lifetime of being a model student, sixteen-year-old Lucy Szabo is suddenly in trouble at school, at home, with the "proto-vampires" she has met online and in person, and most of all with her uncontrolled diabetes.

Hino, Matsuri: Vampire Knights (Teen Graphic Novel/Manga)

Cross Academy is attended by two groups of students: the day class and the night class. Yuki Cross and Zero Kiryu are the guardians of the school, protecting the day class from the Academy's dark secret: the night class is full of vampires! Series

Jenkins, A.M.: Night Road

Battling his own memories and fears, Cole, an extraordinarily conscientious vampire, and Sandor, a more impulsive acquaintance, spend a few months on the road, trying to train a young man who recently joined their ranks.

Klaue, Annette Curtis: The Silver Kiss

A mysterious teenage boy harboring a dark secret helps Zoe come to terms with her mother's terminal illness. 1st in a series

Marrone, Amanda: Uninvited

Jordan's life sucks. Her boyfriend, Michael, dumped her, slept his way through half the student body, and then killed himself. But now, somehow, he appears at her window every night, begging her to let him in. Jordan can't understand why he wants her, but she feels her resistance wearing down.

Mead, Richelle: Vampire Academy

Two years after a horrible incident made them run away, vampire princess Lissa and her guardian-in-training Rose are found and returned to St. Vladimir's Academy, where one focuses on mastering magic, the other on physical training, while both try to avoid the perils of gossip, cliques, gruesome pranks, and sinister plots. 1st in a series

Pauley, Kimberly: Sucks To Be Me – The All-True Confessions of Mina Hamilton, Teen Vampire (Maybe)

When sixteen-year-old Mina is forced to take a class to help her decide whether or not to become a vampire like her parents, she also faces a choice between her life-long best friend and the boy she has a crush on versus new friends and possible boyfriends in her mandatory "vampire lessons."

Rees, Douglas: Vampire High

When his family moves from California to New Sodom, Massachusetts and Cody enters Vlad Dracul Magnet School, many things seem strange, from the dark-haired, pale-skinned, supernaturally strong students to

Charon, the wolf who guides him around campus on the first day.

Richards, Justin: The Parliament of Blood

In Victorian London, after discovering that vampires really do exist and plot to end the human race, friends try to find ways to stop them from overthrowing Parliament and, eventually, taking over the world.

St. Crow, Lili: Strange Angels

Sixteen-year-old Dru's psychic abilities helped her father battle zombies and other creatures of the "Real World," but now she must rely on herself, a "werewolf"-bitten friend, and a half-human vampire hunter to learn who murdered her parents, and why. 1st in a series

Schreiber, Ellen: Vampire Kisses

Sixteen-year-old Raven, an outcast who always wears black and hopes to become a vampire some day, falls in love with the mysterious new boy in town, eager to find out if he can make her dreams come true. 1st in a series

Shan, Darren: Cirque du Freak

Two boys who are best friends visit an illegal freak show, where an encounter with a vampire and a deadly spider forces them to make life-changing choices. 1st in a series

Smith, Cynthia Leitich: Eternal

When Miranda's guardian angel Zachary recklessly saves her from falling into an open grave and dying, the result is that she turns into a vampire and he is left to try to reinstate his reputation by finally doing the right thing. 1st in a series

Smith, L.J.: The Vampire Diaries – The Awakening and the Struggle

The tale of two vampire brothers and the beautiful girl torn between them. 1st in a series

Stine, R.L.: Dangerous Girls

After sixteen-year-old Destiny and her twin sister Livvy are turned into partial vampires at a summer camp, they try to find the "Restorer," someone who can return them to normal. 1st in a series

Westerfeld, Scott: Peeps

Cal Thompson is a carrier of a parasite that causes vampirism, and must hunt down all of the girlfriends he has unknowingly infected.
