***Untraceable* by Laura Griffin**

***The Bone Garden* by Tess Gerritsen**

The discovery of the skeleton of a woman murdered two centuries earlier sends medical examiner Maura Isles on the trail of a long-dead serial killer who terrorized Boston with crimes in which Norris Marshall, a Harvard Medical School student, had become the prime suspect.

***The Bone Thief* by Jefferson Bass**

Dr. Bill Brockton has been called in on a seemingly routine case, to exhume a body and obtain a bone sample for a DNA paternity test. But when the coffin is opened, Brockton and his colleagues, including his graduate assistant Miranda Lovelady, are stunned to see that the corpse has been horribly violated

***Book of the Dead* by Patricia Cornwell**

Dr. Kay Scarpetta opens a private forensic pathology practice in Charleston, South Carolina, only to find herself and her colleagues-- Pete Marino and her niece, Lucy-- confronted by a horrifying series of crimes that may have an underlying link. Part of the long-running Kay Scarpetta series.

***The Dirty Secrets Club* by Meg Gardiner**

In the wake of an ongoing string of high-profile murder-suicides in San Francisco, forensic psychiatrist Jo Beckett is hired by the SFPD to perform investigative autopsies and discovers a harrowing commonality among the suicide victims.

***Delusion* by G. H. Ephon**

Forensic neuropsychologist and expert defense witness Peter Zak is hired to explore the mind of a brilliant but paranoid man accused of stabbing his wife and must separate fact from fiction, reality from delusion, in this complex case.

***Down the Darkest Road* by Tami Hoag**

Set in the 1980s, California FBI agent Vince Leone taps into the powers of science-based forensic techniques to unveil dark secrets and stop a killer who is terrorizing the citizens of Oak Knoll.

***The Face of Deception* by Iris Johansen**

Forensic sculptor Eve Duncan is persuaded by billionaire magnate John Logan to reconstruct the face of an adult murder victim. It turns out to be a very dangerous job yet as she is left in a specially equipped lab in rural Virginia. Surveillance cameras are everywhere, the phones are tapped and Logan himself acts at once--ruthless, charming and desperate.

***The Girl Who Disappeared Twice* by Andrea Kane**

When they are hired by veteran family court judge Hope Willis to find her missing daughter, Forensic Instincts--a team of renegade investigators comprised of a behaviorist, a techno-wizard, an intuitive, and a former Navy SEAL--must race against time to bring Krissy back alive.

***Good Blood* by Aaron Elkins**

While vacationing on an idyllic Italian island, forensic anthropologist Gideon Oliver and his wife find themselves caught up in a case of kidnapping and murder when the local padrone's only child is abducted, and Gideon joins the investigation.

***The Iron Wymr Affair* by Lilith Saintcrow**

In an alternate London where illogical magic has turned the Industrial Revolution on its head, a forensic sorceress and a failed mentath face hostility, treason, cannon fire, black sorcery, and the problem of reliably finding cabs.

***Lake of Sorrows* by Erin Hart**

Pathologist Nora Gavin investigates two bodies discovered at the site of an Irish midland industrial site--one ancient, the other recent--and teams up with archaeologist Cormac Maguire for an unexpectedly dangerous case.

***Origin* by Diana Abu-Jaber**

New York-based fingerprint expert Lena investigates a series of crib deaths that may actually be the work of a serial killer, a case that reminds Lena of the mystery surrounding her own childhood, marked by her orphaned status and her intuitive talents.
