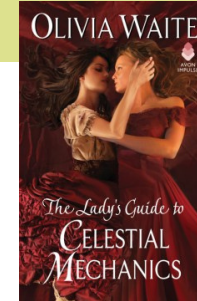
The Boyfriend Project

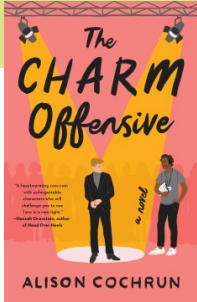
Honey Girl

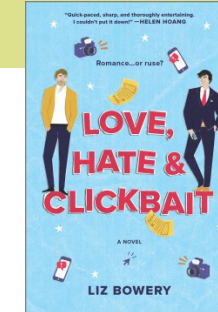
The Charm Offensive

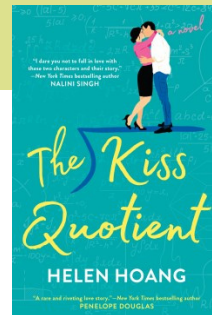

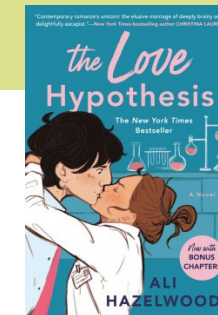
