What is hoopla?

hoopla is a digital streaming service with thousands of videos, music albums, eBooks, audiobooks, and comics.

Sign up with your library card and your email address.

Each month you can borrow up to 8 titles on your account (this number is indicated in a red circle and is viewable when you sign in). This number will change to reflect the number of titles you have remaining for the month as you borrow.

Lending periods are assigned by hoopla. Some of these may vary depending on the publisher:

• eBooks: 21 Days

• Audiobooks: 21 Days

• Comic Books: 21 Days

• Music: 7 Days

• Video: 3 Days

Find hoopla

For a computer:

- Visit <u>hoopladigital.com</u>
- Click the "GET STARTED" button

For cell phones and tablets:

• Download the hoopla app using the app store on your device

Create an Account

For all devices:

- Create an account by selecting Tewksbury Public Library from the dropdown menu
- Enter your library card number when prompted
- Enter your email address and choose a password for your hoopla account
- Click the "Sign Up" button

Find a Title

You can access hoopla's eBooks, audiobooks, videos, and music after signing in to your account:

- Use the search bar to look for a particular author or title
- Browse by category
- Click on an item to see more details about it

Borrow a Title

All hoopla titles are available immediately, with no wait!

- Click the "Borrow" button
- Click on "My hoopla"

Borrowed" under the "My hoopla" menu

For cell phones and tablets - The "My hoopla" button is at the bottom of the screen. Currently borrowed items will appear at the top of that page.
